Bicycles have two wheels. One wheel is in front of the other. You swing your leg over the bike, sit down and start peddling.

The heart of every bicycle is its frames made of thin metal tubes. The best frames are light and strong. A seat, called saddle is in the middle of the frame. You can make the seat higher or lower.

Bicycle wheels usually have wire spokes. Spokes help the wheel keep its round shape. The wheels have brakes for stopping.

A bicycle has handlebars. You use the handbars to steer and help you balance on two wheels. Most bikes have brake levers on the handlebars. You squeeze the levers to make the brakes work.
