Read the following passage and answer questions 6 - 10.

Some people are more sensitive to certain foods or substances than others. Food sensitivity refers to an unpleasant reaction to a specific food or ingredient, which a person may experience while others don't.

Some reactions or symptoms of food intolerance include lip swelling, diarrhoea, asthma, vomiting, headache, malaise and irritability.

The condition can be diagnosed easily, especially if a commonly eaten food causes the reaction. But this may sometimes be difficult if the symptoms are delayed. What makes it even more difficult is the lack diagnostic tests.

Some of the foods that commonly cause food reactions include cow's milk, eggs, nuts such as peanut butter, almond, hazel nuts and other tree nuts, fish like shell fish, legumes such as peas and soya.

Many different gastrointestinal reactions due to food sensitivity may start with symptoms that appear to be unrelated. It may start with lip swelling, vomiting and tingling in the mouth and throat.

Children are at more risk of food reaction, such as to cow milk and egg white, thus the rationale for avoiding the two foods until they are one year and eight months respectively. Cow milk intolerance can cause gastrointestinal bleeding and other factors. Eggs and nuts are known to easily provoke asthma in children. Some foods that contain sulphur include wines, pickled onions and commercial pre-cut chips. Additional symptoms include joint pain.

Migraines can be caused by certain foods and the reaction may not necessarily come immediately after taking the particular food. It may be many hours after eating, so most of the time we do not associate it with the food we eat.
